2025 SUMMER ENRICHMENT SCHEDULE

Each session is two weeks long. A schedule of daily activities. explorations, and field trips will be provided in advance of each session. Parents/guardians are welcome to join, but please make arrangements in advance with program staff, in case reservations are required.

THEME

Both sessions of the 2025 Summer Enrichment Program have the same theme — the United States Congress and Washington, D.C. — and all activities, trips, and special events are based on that theme. Children will experience a wide variety of quality educational, motivational, and recreational activities in a safe, healthy, and fun atmosphere.

MORNING TOWN HALL MEETINGS

Each day begins with a Morning Town Hall meeting to help increase engagement and excitement about the day's scheduled activities, goals, and any special events.

AFTERNOON TOWN HALL MEETINGS

Afternoon Town Hall meetings wrap up the day's events and discuss what was learned, liked, and disliked. This helps staff make any necessary adjustments to the next day's activities.

FIELD TRIPS

Field trips are offered throughout each session to provide an immersive learning experience.

ACTIVITIES

Our program's interactive, age-appropriate activities are designed to help children learn about the rich history behind the United States Congress and the nation's capital.

GROUP GAMES AND OUTDOOR QUESTS

Program session themes are supplemented with activities and excursions beyond the U.S. Capitol. Children get to explore the various institutions that make up the National Mall.

LUNCH

Children must bring their own snack, lunch, and beverage every day.

STAFF

Our counselors bring an outstanding pedagogical experience to the program. They undergo an extensive background check prior to being hired and are CPR/First Aid certified.

PROGRAM RATES

Each two-week session costs \$825. Families registering multiple children will receive 15 percent off the total registration fee. Due to limited space, registration will be accepted on a first-come, first-served basis. Payment in full is required for registration.

AGE RANGE

Designed for children ages 6 to 13 (i.e., 1st to 8th grade).
